Dodd Field History

In 1998, long time Issaquah Little League member Terry Dodd coordinated a deal with the Issaquah School District to develop baseball fields on the swampy, blackberry-infested land between Issaquah Valley Elementary and Issaquah Schools District Administrative building. ILL, with the help of a grant from King County, community business contributors and local volunteers, built the two fields and play began in the spring of 2000. ILL is fully responsible for the maintenance and administration of the fields and in return has priority use of the fields. That property is known to Issaquah Little League Dodd Field today. A truly generous and brilliant asset for our community!

Issaquah Little League's volunteers have taken great pride in maintaining and improving these terrific fields, with upgrades of sprinkler systems, fencing, bleachers, batting cages, landscaping and pathways. Those upgrades continue in 2011 with the new synthetic turf infields and the introduction of a pathway of commemorative bricks leading from the parking lot to the fields.
